This year's Sweetbay Day will restock our Food Pantry and help us provide a Thanksgiving Day Meal for families in need. Last year we received over 3,400 items of canned food, dry food, paper products, etc. We call this Sweetbay Day because of a special arrangement with this local grocery store located on Colonial/Lee Blvd (east of I-75).

The Benevolence Ministry of Christ Community Church has been in operation since 2005. During that year we gave food to 104 families. This year so far we have helped 600 hungry families and individuals. No one goes away empty-handed—thanks to the generous giving of food and financial gifts from our church family and other friends.

Every person is welcomed by one who listens with compassion to their individual situation, offers information concerning helping agencies, gives food from our pantry, and provides other forms of help.

Each 20-30 minute meeting also includes time for prayer and a spiritual conversation that shows them how to have "Peace with God." Every year some have found this peace as they admitted their need for forgiveness and invited Jesus to be their Savior and Lord.
