Robert Sanou, a national worker from Burkina Faso, will speak today. He has served the C&MA related national church in several ministries. This past decade he has served as National Coordinator for ACCEDES in association with CAMA Services in numerous relief and development activities that include health, agriculture, education, environment, and food security. Mr. Sanou holds a law degree from the Univ. of Ouagadougou and a masters degree in project management.

Rev. Tim Albright will assist with translation. Tim & Ruth Albright have served with CAMA Services in Burkina Faso for 23 years—initially as country director and most recently as CAMA Services Regional Consultant for Africa. Since late August, Tim and Ruth have been on special assignment for CAMA Services as employees of ECHO (Educational Concerns for Hunger Organization) here in Fort Myers where he is both Director of Agriculture Training and the Africa Regional Director.
